

RULES OF ORDER

Except as otherwise provided by law, by Maine Department of Education or School Committee policy, Robert's Rules of Order, Revised (latest edition available) shall be used to resolve procedural uncertainties.

The Superintendent, as Secretary to the School Committee, shall function as Parliamentarian and advise the Chair and the School Committee, as necessary, regarding the interpretation of *Robert's Rules*.

The Chair will rule on all questions pertaining to rules of order / parliamentary procedure that may arise during a meeting of the School Committee.

The role of the Parliamentarian shall be advisory only.

Procedural rules may be suspended at any time for the duration of any one meeting by majority vote of the School Committee members present.
